Description:

The Adapted Sports League Summer Camp will develop physical fitness skills throughout 3 different sports such as indoor soccer, indoor floor hockey, and indoor wiffle ball. It is a requirement that the student has a disability recognized by the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) to participate within the camp; students grades 9-12 who are unable to successfully compete with their nondisabled peers. There will be two certified adapted physical education teachers and two support staff members to ensure the student will remain in a safe and successful environment. Prior to working with athletes, all staff members will be CPR, AED, and Non-Violent Crisis Intervention (NVCI) certified per district requirements.

This camp is a lead up to our Adapted Sports League that will take place in the Fall as a school-sponsored extracurricular sports program and athletes will need to complete all three seasons to receive a varsity letter, per league requirements. Each sport will be roughly 6 weeks in Fall - soccer, Winter - floor hockey, and Spring - wiffle ball.
